SILVER GHOST founder Weston Eidson's great-grandfather, John Montagu, was a pioneer in the emerging automobile industry at the turn of the 20th century. As a British Lord and Member of Parliament, he was an instrumental figure in early automotive legislation. Montagu had a close relationship with Charles Rolls and Henry Royce, and suggested that his assistant serve as the model for the Rolls-Royce hood ornament, the Spirit of Ecstasy, which we still see on Rolls-Royce cars to this day. As a tribute to his family's illustrious past, Weston adopted the name of his great-grandfather's favorite car - the 1909 Rolls-Royce Silver Ghost.
